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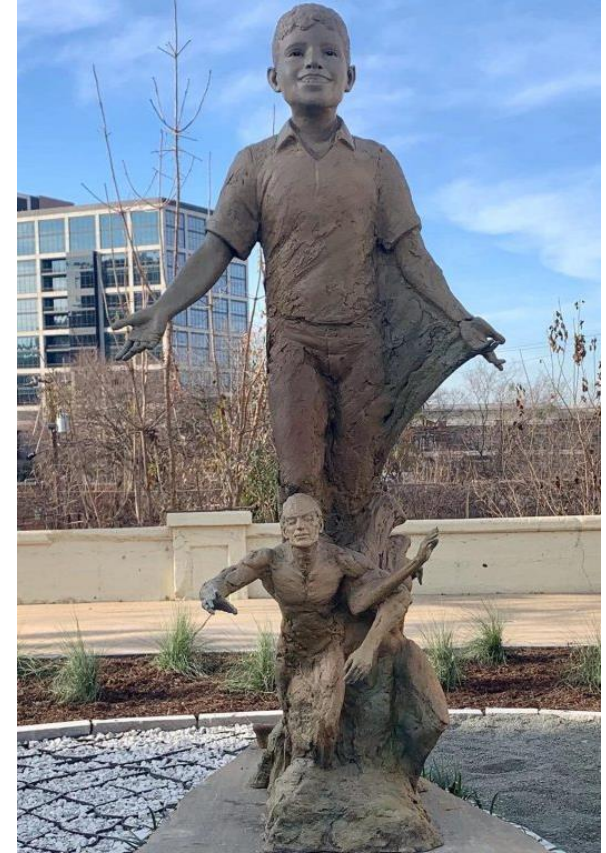

*Enrich the community through the integration of the vision and work of artists into planning, design and construction of public spaces.*

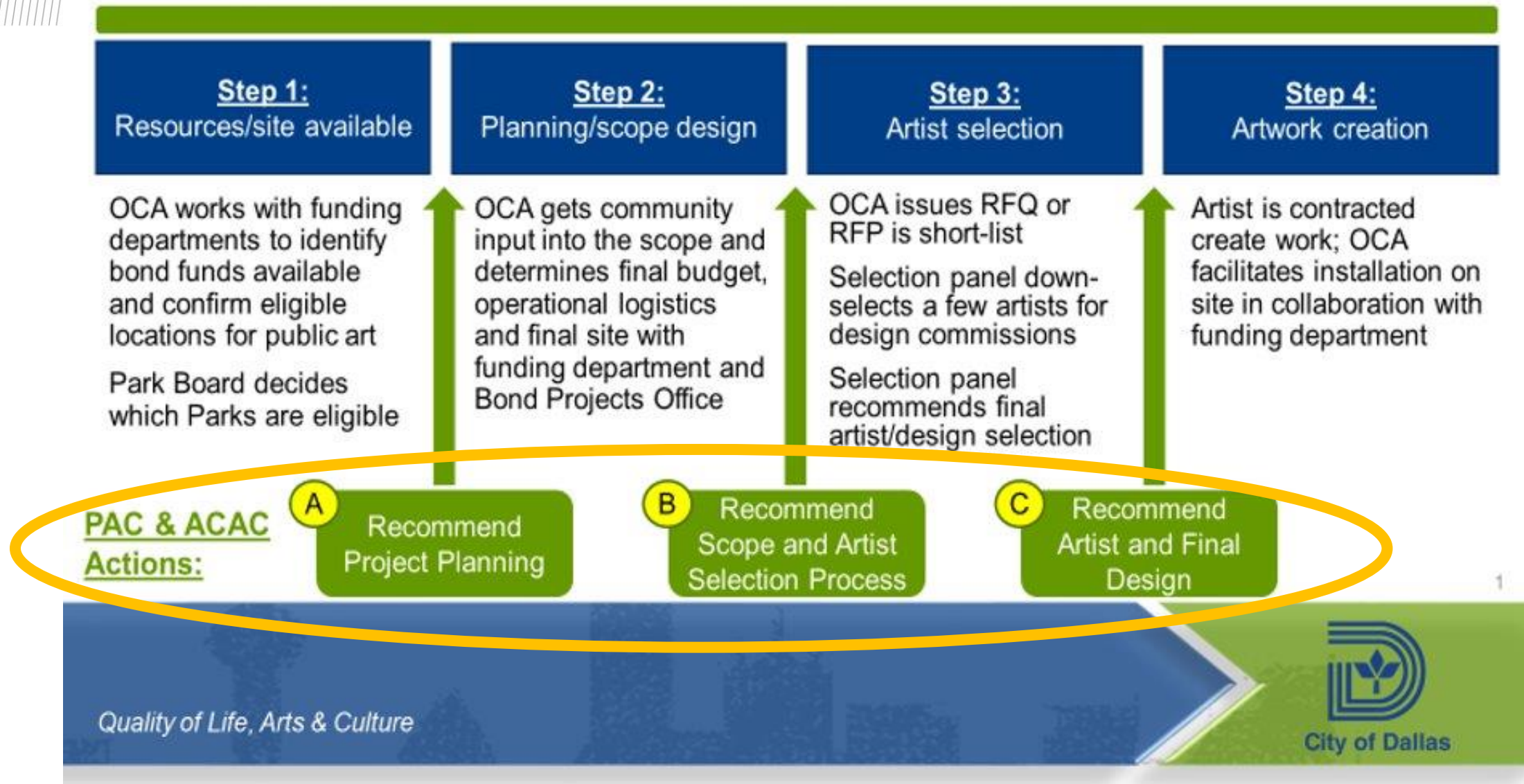


The Public Art Program manages the acquisition and commission of new public art.

# Public Art Committee



**Public Art Committee** is a standing committee of the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission charged with:

- Overseeing the quality of the programs
- Selection and oversight of project panels/juries, including the appointment of arts experts to the selection panel
- Reviewing and recommending projects/artists



The Public Art Committee is composed of 11 members  
(3 commissioners and 8 resident members)



# Public Art Committee



## Arts and Culture Advisory Commission

- Reviews and approves recommendations made by the Public Art Committee for artists / projects prior to City contracting
- Recommends program policies and guidelines

The Arts and Culture Advisory Commission is composed of 18 members appointed by Mayor and Council Members



# Public Art Collection



Public Art Collection is valued at over 125 million dollars.

- Collection includes art projects and cultural objects.
- Collection has over 400 objects.

Roughly, 50% of the artwork in the collection created before 1990. Most given by civic minded donors or Heritage pieces from the Texas 1936 Centennial.

# What is Social Prescribing?



- Social prescribing aims to improve well-being by addressing root causes of health issues.
- It complements traditional medical care by connecting patients with non-medical resources.
- These resources address social determinants of health, like housing, food security, and social isolation.



# Arts on Prescription: General Overview



- Improved health outcomes (reduced stress, depression, anxiety)
- Decreased healthcare costs by addressing upstream health factors
- Increased social connection and community engagement
- Enhanced access to arts and culture
